Sub: Extension of Family Pension to the divorced/widowed daughter beyond 25 years of age : Amendment in Regulation - 6 (j) (2) of WBSEB Employees'(Death-cum-Retirement Benefit) Regulations, 1985.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 79 (c) of the Electricity (Supply) Act 1948, read with Section 172 and Section 185 of the Electricity Act, 2003, the West Bengal State Electricity Board is, hereby, pleased to substitute the existing Regulation - 6 (j) (2) in the West Bengal State Electricity Board Employees'(Death-cum-Retirement Benefit) Regulations, 1985 with the following:

"For the purpose of Family Pension : -

- i) Wife in the case of a male employee,
- ii) Husband in the case of a female employee,
- iii) Sons(including step-sons/adopted sons) upto the age of 25 years,
- iv) Unmarried daughters(including step-daughters/ adopted daughters) upto the age of 25 years.

Note : (1) Adoption after retirement will not be recognized for the purpose of family-pension.

(2) Post-retired spouses will, however, be eligible for family-Pension.


- v) Divorced /Widowed daughter beyond 25 years of age till her remarriage or death.

Note :The benefit shall not be admissible when the eligible daughter has an income exceeding Rs.2,600/-(Rupees two thousand six hundred) only per month from employment in Government, Semi-Government, Statutory Bodies, Corporation, Undertakings, Private Sector, Self employment etc.

- vi) Dependent parents".

This Order shall take immediate effect.

This has reference to Resolution No. 10 adopted in Board Meeting No: 580 dated 25-11-2006.
